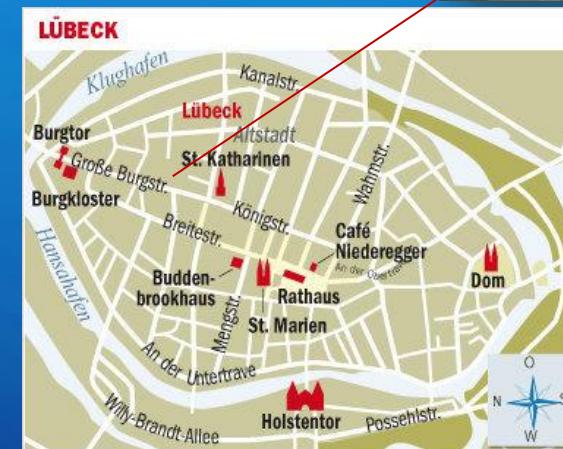
The Fraunhofer Research Institution for Marine Biotechnology (EMB)
