



Declaration of absence of the suspicion of a SARS-CoV-2 infection when participating in a TU Braunschweig face-to-face event

Status: 03.08.2021

I am familiar with the most important **infection protection measures** of TU Braunschweig, such as the social distancing rule (minimum distance of 1.5 m from other persons) to be kept at all times and the obligation to wear a medical face mask (so-called surgical mask or better) in the buildings and in all theoretical and practical courses as well as during written exams.

I hereby certify to the best of my knowledge and belief that

- I do not experience any symptoms that are indicative of a SARS-CoV-2 infection (including, in particular, fever and dry cough) and cannot be explained in any other way,
- I am not banned from the TU Braunschweig by the university administration (e.g. after contact with an infected person in a course),
- I am not under an officially ordered quarantine,
- I have not tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 within the last 14 days,
- I had no contact with a person known to be infected with SARS-CoV-2 within the last 14 days,¹
- I observe the current regulations of the Federal Government and the State of Lower Saxony for people entering and returning to Lower Saxony from abroad and that I am not subject to a quarantine measure prescribed there. Information can be found at (in German only):

- [Optional in exams] I tested myself with a SARS- CoV-2 antigen test.² The result of the test was negative. The test(s) took place on the following days this week:

I am aware of the following **obligation to inform**: If the result of my SARS-CoV-2 antigen test is positive or if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 disease up to 14 days after the event, I am obliged to report this immediately, stating the event and the test date, to: corona_meldung@tu-braunschweig.de.

With your signature you confirm the above declaration. Please fill in the following fields completely and sign the declaration.

In accordance with the "Niedersächsische Corona-Verordnung", this declaration will be kept for three weeks after the end of the event and will be presented to the competent authority upon request and destroyed after the retention time. I also agree to this.

¹ Exempted from this regulation are those who have been fully vaccinated and those who have recovered and can present an appropriate proof. There is no exemption if there has been exposure to a variant of the SARS-CoV-2 virus that is not yet widespread in Germany and has properties of concern defined by the RKI (currently: beta (B.1.351) or gamma (P1)).

² There are exemptions for fully vaccinated and recovered persons (cf. Classroom Teaching: Test Strategy for Students).
