Starting your studies is exciting and a big step in your life. To make it a success, we are happy to support you even before the start of your first semester:

- ► At the International House you will get all the answers and find many personal advisory services covering everything from the application process to the start of your studies.
- As soon as you have been admitted, you can apply for the Erasmus Student Network Buddy Programme. Your Buddy will support you during your first days in Braunschweig and will also answer any questions you may have before your arrival.
- The Welcome Week for international students takes place the week before lectures start. This is where you get to know the University and other international students and find out everything you need to know to start your studies.



Things are much easier when you study together. We support you in getting to know local and international students and in making contacts:

- The Lunch Breaks and Coffee Breaks are a great opportunity to meet fellow students and to strike up a conversation over lunch in the Mensa (canteen) or in a café nearby.
- The Erasmus Student Network organises many exciting events every semester. There is something for everyone from city tours to bowling evenings.
- The SCOUT programme pairs you up with local students who support you in living and studying in Germany.
- Student initiatives such as Enactus or AIESEC offer you the opportunity to get involved in different ways and meet other people while studying.

- Students from Faculties 3 and 4 can participate in the inTU programme, where they receive a lot of support in organising their studies.
