

Checklist for research data publication

- I have saved my data in a comprehensible folder structure.
- My folder and file naming is systematic, content-related and clear.
- I have identified data that is worthy of archiving and selected published data that reflects the scientific relevance of my work.
- My data is available in common, freely accessible file formats (e.g. XML, CSV, TXT, TIFF).
- I have maintained comprehensive documentation that enables reproducibility and reuse of the data set, and created a separate README file (TXT or PDF/A) with descriptive metadata.
- I have ensured that I am not violating any third-party rights (e.g. data protection, copyright, confidentiality agreements) or ethical concerns by publishing it.
- I have selected a suitable license (e.g. Creative Commons) for subsequent use.
