



## Guideline on continuing education within the framework of the doctorate

Every doctoral candidate is subject to the obligation of continuing education (see §6 /3 Doctorate Regulations). This continuing education can take place on three levels:

### 1. Subject-specific continuing education

All TU Braunschweig courses at Master's level are available here. In addition, in-depth basic lectures are offered specifically for doctoral students via GradTUBS.

### 2. Interdisciplinary continuing education

This includes further education measures in the areas of personal development, communication, methodological skills, leadership skills, career planning, setting up a company, copyright, good scientific practice, language courses. The GradTUBS offers are available here.

### 3. Scientific communication

This includes active participation in summer schools, internal departmental colloquia, publications, conference contributions, taking on teaching tasks, helping to write research proposals, stays at external scientific institutions or companies, e.g. in the context of cooperation projects / scientific collaboration.

## General information

The selection of the events to be attended and the determination of any stays at external scientific institutions or companies are carried out by the supervisor together with the doctoral candidate. The scope of the continuing education measures is determined by so-called "continuing education days". The supervisor determines the number of continuing education days recognised for each measure. In the case of seminars, this corresponds to the actual number of seminar days; in the case of other measures, it corresponds to the time spent on content-related work. The total number of continuing education days is regulated by the doctoral regulations.
