### Name change of the Electrical Engineering degree programme

Dear students of the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes in Electrical Engineering,

The "Electrical Engineering" degree programme will be renamed "Electrical Engineering and Information Technology" in the winter semester 2025/26, see examination regulations PO 5. As a student of the previous "Electrical Engineering" degree programme, you can continue to obtain your degree in the Bachelor's or Master's degree programme with the name "Electrical Engineering".

If you are a student of the previous "Electrical Engineering" degree programme and would like to obtain a Bachelor's or Master's degree with the name "Electrical Engineering and Information Technology", you have until 30 September 2026 to switch to the new examination regulations (PO 5). To do so, please send an email to [pruefungsamt-et-eitp@tu-braunschweig.de](mailto:pruefungsamt-et-eitp@tu-braunschweig.de) with the subject "Application to change to PO 5". Please note that a subsequent change back to your previous examination regulations is not possible.

**Students of the current PO 4** can continue to study according to it up to and including 31 March 2030 without having to apply.

**For students of earlier examination regulations (PO 1 to 3)**, the deadline ends on 30 September 2027, after which they will be transferred to the Special Examination Regulations for the Bachelor's or Master's degree programme in Electrical Engineering and Information Technology (PO 5).
