#### Welcome,

I am pleased to present to you the Leaflet for the year 2021. This offers some selected insights that should allow you to get a deeper impression of our Carolo Wilhelmina. I would like to pick out a few points here:

- In six faculties and 130 institutes approximately 17,800 students are educated in 84 degree programs.
- Thanks not least to our third-party funding successes, we had a budget of almost 394 million euros in 2021.
- More than 3,300 graduates completed their degree at TU Braunschweig in 2021.
- Over 400 partner institutes and research facilities in more than 60 countries are evidence of a broadly anchored internationalization.
- The proportion of international students at TU has also been rising steadily for years, reaching a new high of 18.5% in 2021.
- An increase can also be observed in the number of full-time employees and doctoral students.




