Operation and usage of the WAP cluster

 The WAP cluster has an official supervisor (OS).
Currently the OS is: Prof. Dr. Wolfram Brenig, Institute for Theoretical Physics.

2. The OS:

- supervises proper usage of the cluster
- grants access to the cluster or bans users from usage
- assigns system maintenance work to users
- 3. Administration: There is
 - **no** system administrator (the OS is no system administrator)
 - **no** user support
 - **no** dedicated personnel for system maintenance
- 4. System maintenance:

By using the cluster, each user accepts that she/he will carry out system maintenance work on short notice by request through the OS.

- 5. Root access and user accounts:
 - The OS assigns root access to a single person among the users.
 - This person will install new users and allow for system boot and shutdown. This person is no system administrator.
 - The WAP cluster allows for users from the:
 - Institute of Theoretical Physics
 - Institute of Mathematical Physics
- 6. Software:

The operating system and software of the cluster is 'as-is'. System-wide installation and/or update of software will not be performed.

- 7. Load / Job control / disk usage:
 - Public nodes of the cluster are: 1 42
 - Jobs must be started with 'nice 19'
 - No job is to be started on the 'phycluster' node
 - The cluster has no load balancing system, batch queue, or alike
 - There is no fixed dedication of nodes or CPU time to particular users
 - Users are expected to communicate in order to optimize CPU usage
 - Each user is granted no more than 10GB disk space
- 8. Users unable to comply with these rules will be banned from the cluster
